

Ruidoso Municipal School Food Service Information

The Ruidoso Municipal School participates in the National School Lunch Program. Meals are prepared and served daily to Ruidoso School students. These meals are designed to meet 1/3 of the average child's daily nutritional requirements. Ruidoso Municipal Schools is committed to providing nourishing meals to all students wanting our services.

How does my child qualify for free or reduced lunch?

Applications for Free and Reduced Meals must to be updated every year. In order to qualify for the current school year, you must re-apply, even if you qualified last year. If you qualified last school year, you will be pre-qualified for the first **30 days** of school **only**. Please submit the application form as soon as possible. Each child will be provided with an application form to bring home and Free or Reduced applications can now be **filled out on-line** at <http://www.ruidososchools.org/district-nutrition.asp> Additional forms are available from your school office. Ruidoso Municipal Schools audits 3% of all applications on a yearly basis in order to comply with USDA audit requirements. These applications are selected at random starting in October of each year.

How do I pay for school lunches?

Each campus in the Ruidoso School District uses "FastLane" a point of sale system that allows the cafeteria to operate more efficiently and enable improved record keeping. When your student is enrolled an account is set up for them so that he/she can purchase lunch without having cash everyday. You may deposit as much or as little as you would like into your students account. When he/she enters the cafeteria, the student chooses what he/she wants to buy and proceeds to the cashier station. Each student is given an identification number that is entered into the computer at the end of the line. This will bring up the student's account on the screen. The cashier will key in what the student selected. The computer will calculate the balance and the student just goes to their seat to enjoy their lunch. For security the computer records what is purchased and will prompt the cashier if a pin number was entered more than once.

****Reminder:** notices are printed every two weeks and given to students when their account balance reaches less than \$1.00. ******

****Reminder:** Reminder slips will be given you each child by the cashier prior to their account falling into the negative.

Even those students paying cash will need to enter their identification number so the cafeteria can track meals to comply with federal guidelines. You have an option of paying cash each day. However, the point of sale system and the lunch line move more quickly when each student has an account.

On-line payments

Ruidoso School District now offers **MyPaymentsPlus** (www.mypaymentsplus.com)

a new service that provides parents with the opportunity to pay for student meals via the internet or telephone. Parents no longer have to worry about forgetting to give their children money for the cafeteria or worry about their losing it!

The MyPaymentsPlus payment system allows families to:

- * Access the system 24/7
- * View account balances and payment history
- * Split payments for multiple students in one or more schools
- * Receive confirmations of payments and low balance reminders via e-mail
- * Deposit funds using a Visa/Master Card or Debit Card
- * Receive Live Chat or toll-free support from friendly and courteous staff
- * Stop worrying about lost or forgotten lunch money

With **MyPaymentsPlus**, money can be deposited into individual student accounts by phone or the Internet through an e-check or by using debit or credit cards. A small convenience fee of 4.75% per transaction is charged for using this service. The convenience fee is paid directly to **MyPaymentsPlus** and is used to cover credit card and other payment processing fees and is not collected by the school district.

4. Follow the onscreen directions to set up your account.
5. Deposit funds to your child's account using the secure Web site.

If you prefer to use MyPaymentsPlus via Telephone:

1. Call (866) 215-8467 to enroll and make your payment over the phone.

Of course, parents may continue to pay for their child's meals directly at school in the cafeteria by check or cash. Can my child charge a meal?

Ruidoso Middle/High School Lunch Charge Policy

Students in grades 6-12 will no longer be able to charge breakfast or lunch meals in the cafeteria. Students can use their meal accounts, but will need to have money in their account, use cash or check to pay for their meals.

Sierra Vista Primary/White Mountain Elementary School Lunch Charge Policy

Students in grades 1-5 will be allowed to charge up to \$10.00 in the cafeteria. When a low-balance occurs in an account, a low-balance reminder slip will be handed to the child. This will indicate that the child has a low balance and will need funds the next day before a deficit takes place. An automated phone call and e-mail will also be sent to the phone number and e-mail address on file at the child's school. If the limit of \$10.00 in charges is reached the student will be provided a Cheese Sandwich, fruit and milk. The meal charge will still be added to the child's account and this meal will be given until there is a payment made on the account, which will bring the account below the \$10.00 limit.

Nob Hill Early Childhood Center Lunch Charge Policy

Students in grades Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten will be allowed to charge in the cafeteria. When the limit of \$10.00 in charges is reached a conference with the parent or guardian will be arranged.

IF A STUDENT HAS MONEY IN THEIR ACCOUNT IT WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR THE FIRST DAY. IF THE STUDENT HAD PRIOR CHARGES THAT WERE NOT PAID OVER THE SUMMER THEY WILL ALSO BE ON THE STUDENTS ACCOUNT.**
