

## Pandemic Addendum

1. Facial Coverings for medical purposes and disease prevention. (Masks and Face Shields)
  - a. Inappropriate masks or accessories that advertise, display, or promote any drug (including tobacco or alcohol), sexual innuendo, violence, weaponry, profanity, gang affiliation, hatred bigotry towards any group) are not acceptable.
  - b. The state has stated that bandanas, scarfs, gaiters, and similar face coverings are not acceptable.
  - c. All face shields must be accompanied by an approved cloth or medically approved mask.

Students must keep Face Masks on During the entire school Day. Face masks must be worn all day while on school campuses, at school-sponsored events and on school transportation. The only time the face mask may be off is while eating and drinking during allowed times.

Schools may provide supervised mask breaks for small groups of students outdoors, while maintaining more than 6 feet social distancing between individuals. While waiting for parent pick up, the student will be supervised and quarantined from other students, six-foot lines are provided on sidewalks.

If a student removes the face mask and refuses to wear the mask during other times, then the student will have to be picked up from school and taken home.

The New Mexico Public Education Department allows Local school districts and charter school policies set forth the number of times a student may remove a face mask and the number of warnings a student may receive prior to being sent home to work remotely. If a student is reminded two (2) times to wear his/her face covering correctly, the student will be placed in a quarantine setting until a parent/guardian can take the student home to work remotely for the remainder of the day. The second time a student is removed from school for insubordination, that student will be placed on a remote learning platform for the remainder of the semester.

2. Pandemic re-entry protocols with consequences.
  - a. Refusal to clean desks.
  - b. Refusal to sit where instructed by the teacher.
  - c. Refusal to follow the social distancing/directional arrows and/or maintaining social distancing and physical contact.
  - d. Follow procedures as outlined by all school personnel.
  - e. Stay as directed by administration and lunch monitors during lunch and recess.
  - f. Wear you badge around the neck visibly every day.
  - g. Sharing food, eating food other than breakfast or lunch times.
  - h. Must follow all safety protocols in place.

If a student is reminded two (2) times to conduct his/her self correctly, in accordance with RMSD/RMS pandemic policies the student will be placed in a quarantine setting until a parent/guardian can take the student home to work remotely for the remainder of the day. . The second time a student is removed from school for insubordination, that student will be placed on a remote learning platform for the remainder of the semester.

3. Dress Code will be strictly enforced as outlined in the RMS handbook. The dress code may also be located online at the RMS website and the RMS Facebook site.
4. Remote behavior
  - a. Cameras are to remain on unless otherwise specified by the teacher.
  - b. Students are to remain "framed" up on the screen for engagement.
  - c. Students must follow all protocols outlined by the teacher for remote learning.
  - d. Do not access platforms, links or websites deemed inappropriate.

### Technology Learning Policies

Students must follow the learning platform etiquette guidelines. Apex will be the only learning platform available through RMS for remote learners.

### Expectations and Consequences

Students are expected to use their Chromebooks for school purposes. They should not be on YouTube, Netflix, social media sites or playing games during class time. They need to use their time to complete assignments and submit them. Students will receive an email or have a conversation with the teacher if it is the first offense. Navigating inappropriate sites will be dealt with immediately in accordance with the RMS disciplinary matrix. If the student continues to break policies, a phone call will be made home. On the second offense, a behavioral referral will be issued.
