This Tuesday, as well as future Mondays and Tuesdays, will be “Blue” days; while Thursdays and Fridays will again be “Gold” days.

The latest from the New Mexico Public Education Department (PED) is that plans continue to evolve and progress regarding the return of middle and high school students. Unfortunately, we do not have any information on a possible return date at this time.
