I would like to thank our educational partners with the Mescalero Apache Tribe, as well as Mr. Frizzell Frizzell, Dashina Enjady, and Trudy Gaines for helping support our recent SVP/WME Native Parent Night at the Inn of the Mountain Gods. Thanks to all the parents and students who attended as well.

The legislative session has ended and the fate of bills rests with the Governor. House Bill 130 (HB-130) has already been signed by the Governor and will mandate increased time (1140 hours) for New Mexico schools. Elementary schools will be required to schedule 1080 hours for instruction and an additional 60 hours for professional development, while secondary schools will be required to schedule 1110 hours for instruction with 30 hours for professional development. These mandated changes could force the District to alter daily start – end times for students and/or add additional days to the school year. We hope to iron out a daily schedule and a full 2023-24 school calendar in the coming weeks. Stay tuned.
