For the 100<sup>th</sup> day of school, SVP students created projects representing 100 items.



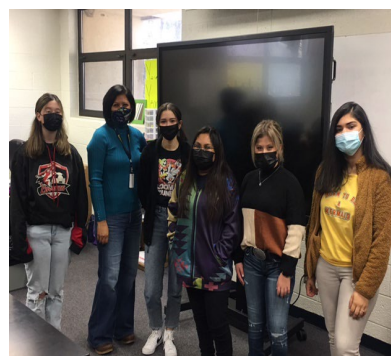
## WME
