On Wednesday evening of this past week we recognized and celebrated the academic accomplishments of over 110 students from WME, RMS, and RHS at "High 5 Night." These students scored "Advanced" on one or more sections of last spring's state assessments. Thank you to all family members who packed the Convention Center in support of our students.

We are one month away from election Tuesday (November 7, 2023) and the District has two referendi on the ballot and neither will increase property taxes! The first is asking for continuance of the Senate Bill 9 (SB9) two-mill levy. These funds primarily support our maintenance efforts at all our facilities. The second issue is requesting community support for the issuance of \$12 million in general obligation bonds. Bond funds are used for more involved construction/facilities projects. 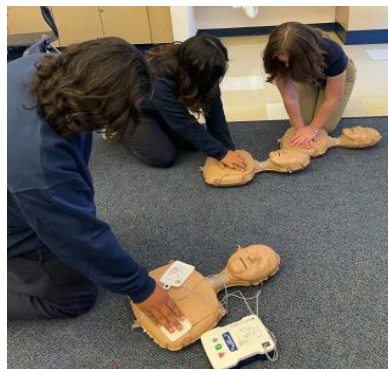
