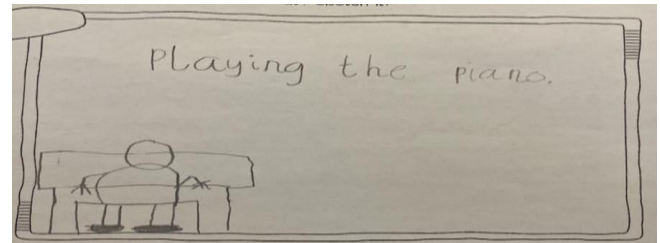

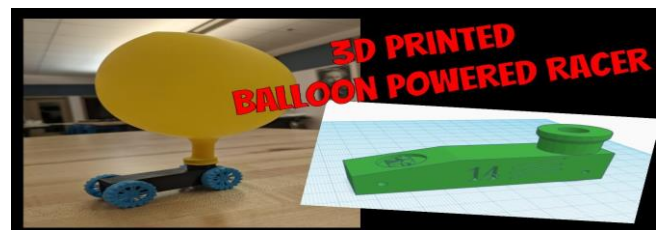
SVP: All 1st and 2nd grade students participated in lessons focused on identifying their unique individual strengths!
